ENROLMENT FAQ's

1. What are the core subjects for year 7?

English, Mathematics, Humanities, Science, Religious Education, Wellbeing & Indonesian

2. How many periods per day and what are the times for lunch and recess?

There are 6 x 50 minute periods each day, on a 10-day cycle. Recess time is at 10.50 - 11.10am and lunchtime is 12.50 – 1.35pm.

3. How many choices are there for Year 7 & 8 subjects?

Art, Music, Food, Wood & Metal Technology and Drama. These 6 electives are spread over the year. Every student will complete all electives.

4. How often are the Assemblies and Liturgies?

Generally, assemblies are held every second Wednesday in the East Stadium in the Chevalier Centre. It is compulsory for school blazers to be worn to all assemblies. Liturgies are held each year in accordance with the church calendar year.

5. What are the benefits from the MSC in Action Program?

Year 7 students take part in the 'MSC in Action' Program (MSC Latin abbrev. For Missionaries of the Sacred Heart). Every second Friday afternoon as part of the

Wellbeing Program. Students are involved in community projects such as gardening, visiting and sharing afternoon tea with the elderly and cooking for the homeless. This program aligns perfectly with the school's MSC ethos of caring, kindness and humility.

6. What are the hours for the Uniform Shop and where do I purchase the uniform?
