BOARDING SCHOLARSHIP

- Covering letter (written by student applying for scholarship)
- Photo of the applicant to be attached to the letter
- Copies of most recent Academic reports and NAPLAN Test results
- Copies of certificates and/or awards
- Evidence of involvement in school and co-curricular activities such as sports, service clubs, cultural activities etc.
- References from teachers, tutors, coaches etc.
- Involvement in local parish or church activities

SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP/ BURSARY

This Bursary is available and awarded on the basis of financial need. A separate Special Bursary form must be completed and is available by contacting the Registrar.

Information to include with Special Scholarship/Bursary application;

- a letter from parents indicating financial need
